The format for the 8/28/07 shoot was a single round of 10 birds for each shooter. Shooters were permitted two shells per bird. The format for the 7/22/07 shoot was "shoot till you miss" up to 10 birds, and a shoot-off for 10 bird ties, which included doubles. There was one shoot-off at that shoot.
